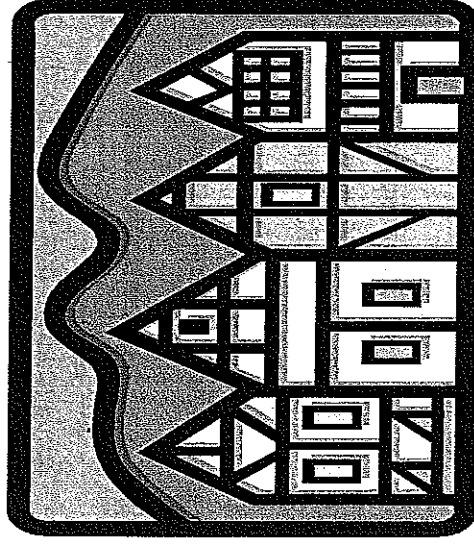

## Fact Sheet

- We provide financial and technical assistance for deleading, education and training.
- We guide homeowners through the entire process of deleading, including setting up an inspection, job specifications and scope of work, bidding, project oversight and temporary relocation.
- All projects will result in a letter of Full Deleading Compliance.
- The grant program is geared towards low-income families with children under 6.
- You do not need to pay back any grant funds.

- Single family homes may receive up to \$20,000\*.
- Multi-family homes may receive up to \$16,000\* per unit.
- You must agree to rent to low-income tenants and give preference to families with children under 6 years of age for a three-year period. (Affordable Housing Restriction)
- Tenants may receive a \$600\* relocation stipend.
- In some cases we can offer a loan if the total cost of the deleading project is over the grant amount, only when funding is available.

## Who Qualifies?

- Both owner-occupied and investor properties are eligible.
- Owner-occupants and their tenants must qualify as low-income.
- Applications for homeowners and tenants are available upon request.
