In-home vaccinations are available for homebound people who are not able to leave their home to get to a vaccination site, even with assistance. These individuals either:

Have considerable difficulty and/or require significant support to leave the home for medical appointments

Require ambulance or two-person assistance to leave the home

Are not able to leave the home for medical appointments under normal circumstances

How to schedule a homebound vaccination

If you are eligible for an in-home vaccination, you can call the
Homebound Vaccination Central Intake Line at (833) 983-0485.

You will be able to speak with a representative who will ask questions to determine if an in-home vaccination is appropriate. If in-home vaccination is appropriate, you will be registered with the State Homebound Vaccine Provider

What an amazing collaboration and partnership that the Council on Aging Staff and Volunteers collaborated on during this pandemic.

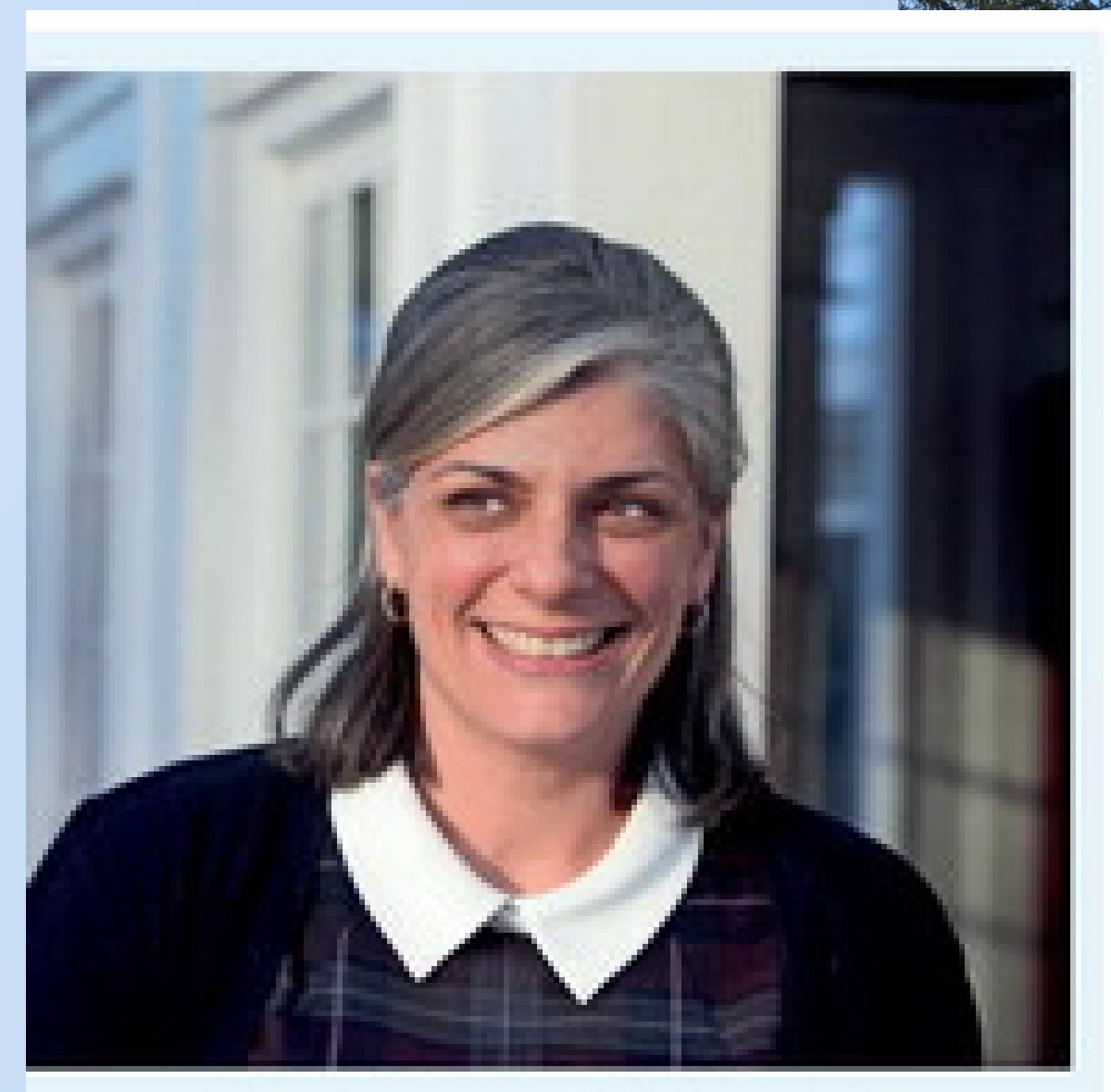
