- Our team has reached out to the Essex Sheriff's office to discuss possible contributions – in-kind or otherwise – to the Municipal Building Project.
- I met with members of Public Safety, Public Works, Council on Aging, Public Health, and MELD for a storm preparedness meeting last week in advance of the arrival of Hurricane Idalia. We will be holding this type of “Storm Awareness and Preparedness” meetings going forward in advance of any predicted severe weather event.
